A.I.M. (Assistance In Mission) is designed for high school students who have already committed themselves to the road of discipleship with Jesus and desire to gain deeper insight into what it means to be an ambassador of the Kingdom of God. Through a unique and intense ministry approach, AIM will both encourage and challenge your faith, giving you space to take major steps in your relationship with Christ, while stretching you to discover your purpose within his redemptive work throughout all of creation. Directed by a qualified and committed staff, AIMers will have the opportunity to be a part of a small community of other students and embark on a two week intensive discipleship course, committed to in-depth Bible study, acts of service, intentional worship, and fellowship with other students in a similar place within their faith.

There are a total of three two-week sessions offered for each summer and session size is limited in order to maintain the integrity of the program. Students going into tenth grade up through college freshman are invited to apply, but only completed applications will be evaluated and considered toward the applicant’s acceptance into a session.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete the enclosed **AIM Application Form** and **Registration Form**.
- Meet with your Sponsor and fill out **Sponsor Form** together.
- Submit the **Personal Reference Form** to a Christian teacher, employer, or church elder not related to you and have them complete the form and send it to Calvin Crest. (Note: Your Sponsor and Personal Reference must be two different people.)
- Submit your completed AIM Application and Registration Form by the Fax/Email/Mailing Address listed at the bottom of the page. **Completed AIM Packets are due no later May 1st, 2014.**

Please DO NOT send payment at this time. A \$125 Non-Refundable deposit will be due upon acceptance to the program. Full payment is due no later than two weeks before your session begins.

NOTE: Incomplete applications will not be processed. No application will be processed until Registration Forms, Personal Reference Forms and Sponsor Forms have been received. It is the responsibility of the applicant to complete all application requirements.
